



At **in8Ed** we want to see children understanding their unique brilliance and how they can impact the world in a positive way. We believe an education system that is informed by a deeper understanding of the brain and how we learn is the key to empowering educators to achieve this.

Through the in8model, developed by Dr Mark Postles and adapted to education by Chelsea Horner, we focus on 4 areas:

2. Celebrating Brilliance – For Teachers

Through our Level 1-3 courses, we empower the individual educator with a deeper understanding of brain function and neuroplasticity. With a focus on practical application in the classroom, educators learn how to shape learning environments, lessons and responses to behaviour through 'speaking the language of the brain'.

This provides opportunities for more children to thrive in school and beyond and creates a more rewarding and enjoyable environment for the educator.

We guide teachers towards a life they are proud of, free of frustration and powerlessness and help them feel joyful in their day to day activities in the classroom and excited about the future. We help them by expanding their understanding of themselves and others struggles, abilities and perspectives.

They identify their point of power within the system in those areas that they can change and influence and break through it for a more effective and satisfying experience for all where the attention is back on their real reason for becoming a teacher – the student.

3. Developing Culture – For Executives

The in8model informs us of the quadrants of our individual brains, but also reflects the parts that make up a thriving organisation. Through a tailored approach, we provide consultation specific to your school context to develop a thriving culture in the in8model areas. We guide the school community through:

1. Refining Vision, Mission and Purpose and developing a unified approach to these goals.
2. Establishing organisational processes including roles, responsibilities and communication.
3. Developing a strong and cohesive team through an understanding of each other and leveraging off strengths through an understanding of brain quadrant preferences.
4. Looking at possibilities of change and assisting in shaping the next focus for the school community.

This approach may include the complete process or a focus on one of the individual areas depending on the context of each school.

4. Shifting Paradigms - For Academics
